Contact details of UK consignee in transport order 	UK company EU based company
<input type="checkbox"/> EXPORT DECLARATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the export accompanying declaration (EAD) is created independently, provide the Movement Reference Number (MRN) of the EAD in the transport order and handover EAD to driver. From January 1, 2021 also required for goods values below EUR 1,000 	
<input type="checkbox"/> COMMERCIAL INVOICE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide electronic copy of commercial invoice. The customs duties and valued added tax are calculated on the basis of the value of goods and currency. Include EORI of Exporter and for UK-destined goods EORI of Importer To utilize the customs easement, the Statement on Origin (incl. REX-number of registered exporter if goods value exceed €6000) needs to be included 	REX in Germany REX in UK

<input type="checkbox"/> UK IMPORT PROCEDURE: FULL DECLARATION OR CFSP EASEMENT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Border Operating Model outlines UK import options, which need to be confirmed and initiated prior to EU export. Inform Kuehne+Nagel if UK import will use the CFSP easement (EORI of importer suffices to enter UK) or full import declaration (Entry Number "ENO" of Import Declaration required to enter UK). If Kuehne+Nagel is not commissioned to prepare full import declaration, provide the ENO in transport order. 	UK Border Operating Model
